Updated guidance on reducing the risk of infection with the coronavirus (COVID-19)

In response to the changing situation relating to the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19), the Grand Secretary has reviewed the guidance given to all MMH Units in the joint statement issued with UGLE and the Ancient & Accepted Rite last week and updated it. Please read the briefing on this link carefully and note the guidance to members in the higher risk categories; the option to postpone planned meetings or abandon them if there is an insufficient attendance; and the requirement from next Monday not to hold any meetings where more than 100 people may attend.



Pushing the boat out in the north-east corner


