The member's manufacturing business has designed a plastic injection mould capable of producing up to 2,500 plastic visors per week. Visors are currently being made and will shortly be available for shipping to Provinces. Shipments will be flat-packed, consisting of:

- 100 plastic frames
- 100 PVC or PET 200-300 micron shield secured to frames by end users, simply snapping the two parts together (see Easy Assembly Guide).
